East Carolina Anesthesia Associates (ECAA), is currently seeking 20 fulltime CRNAs/GRNAs/SRNAs to join its rapidly expanding group practice of 19 Anesthesiologists and 43 CRNAs. ECAA provides exclusive anesthesia services to Pitt County Memorial Hospital, a 730 bed Level 1 Trauma Center with 36 ORs and a free - standing Surgery Center with 8 ORs.

ECAA handles approximately 32,000 anesthetics per year for all types of surgical procedures excluding transplants and burns. ECAA CRNAs practice with a high degree of autonomy to include line placement and some regional anesthesia techniques. CRNAs currently work a flexible schedule that includes 8, 10, 12, and 16 hour shifts, the 16 hour shifts are optional. Beeper call is taken from home on average 2 shifts a month and a Saturday or Sunday a month (NOT THE ENTIRE WEEKEND). New grads will be expected to work primarily 8 and 10 hour shifts for the 1st year. Additional overtime and call are available if desired.
